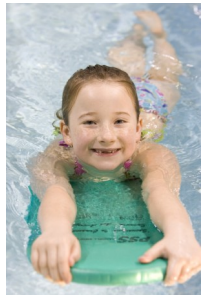


## Who We Are...

## Why Should I join IPRA?



### **Develop Professional Contacts**

*You will interact with others park people at the district level. Each gathering will include; an educational session, park tour and provide opportunity for networking, communicating and building relationships with other park staff.*

### **Enhance Your Education**

*IPRA sponsors workshops, events, and programs designed to meet the needs of park and recreation professionals. Certification courses are offered throughout the year and all workshops offer CEU's.*

### **Attend the State Conference**

*The State Conference is held each January. We offer you an opportunity to come together for educational sessions, social gatherings, and an awards banquet honoring your peers. Exhibitors have on display the latest and greatest equipment for recreational activities.*

Full-time Park & Recreation Professionals  
 Level 1. Income \$0—\$24,999 **\$69**  
 Level 2. Income \$25,000—\$34,999 **\$81**  
 Level 3. Income \$35,000+ **\$92**

### Associate (volunteers) \$29

A full or part-time person interested in supporting IPRA but not eligible to hold any other type of membership.

### Student \$29

Any full-time student taking 12 hrs or more.

### Retired Professional \$29

Retired Park & Recreation Professional.

### Elected Officials \$29

Any groups having appointed or elected commission or board members delivering park, recreation or related services in Indiana.

## Group Membership

### Agency \$345

Any public agency on the municipal, county or state level providing parks and recreation services. This membership includes six members one of which must be a Board Member or elected official.

*Additional professional: \$63 per person*

*Additional board members: \$40 per person*

### Organization \$115

Academic institutions, military installations, non-profit agencies, and other organizations providing parks, recreation and leisure services not covered under public agency membership. This membership includes a maximum of 5 members.
